Esthetics

Students will be tested on their knowledge of skin care including identifying and diagnosing skin conditions. Massage, basic facials, proper sterilization and sanitation procedures and the application of both day and Fantasy make-up.

Clothing Requirement

For Men: Official SkillsUSA white dress shirt, black dress slacks, black socks and black leather work or dress shoes.

For Women: Official white top, black dress slacks, black socks or black/skin-tone hose and black leather, work or dress shoes.

For Models: Business-like, white, collar-less blouse; black dress slacks or skirt, black or skin tone hose and black shoes.

Contestants will have to do everything the state board requires. Sanitation is very important.

(45 minutes) Basic Facial

Contestants will have to perform a basic facial on a live client. They must have knowledge of massage techniques.

(10 minutes) Clean-up

(45 minutes) Day-time make-up

Contestants will have a day time make-up portion

(60 minutes) Fantasy Make-up

Contestants will have a fantasy make-up portion and must print a theme on one sheet of paper that will be posted at their station.

(30 minutes) Lunch

Contestants room 800, judges room 301

(90 minutes) Written exam - 100 questions

(30 minutes) Oral Exam (Will only be administered if time permits)

Contestants will be interviewed by the judges (10-15 minutes)

****The students will need a resume. ****

Supplies

Supplied by the contestant:

1. **Model:** Models must be student members, but not necessarily from an esthetics program and may be either a high school or college student from any school in the state; must be dressed appropriately as described in the required clothing statement; must have hair pulled away from the face with a white or black headband (cloth or plastic); must have a clean, cosmetic-free face; and, must not wear earrings, facial piercings or necklaces (jewelry may be worn in the fantasy portion of the contest).
2. Contestants may supply crock-pots to use as towel warmers and a large bowl.
3. Contestants are required to bring all make-up items. Models will not be required to take the Professional Development Test, the skill related written test or submit a résumé'.
