

Skills USA Georgia Competition Guidelines:

Congratulations on making it to the State Competitions. I hope we have some National winners this year!!!!

We have designated an area at the GICC for the technical, architectural & animation competitions. The students are required to bring their own equipment (this is in line with the National Skills Comp) and will have ½ hour to step up.

Other Things to remember:

- Do I have a CD Burner or Jump Drive?
- Do I have an extra CD to burn to?
- Do I have an Extension Cord?
- Do I have the software needed to complete my competition installed and running properly?
- If software has been loaded from the network make sure you have access to the software outside of the network. For those running Autodesk Products, you may check/borrow licenses out so that they run like a standalone installation. All you need to do is click on HELP, Product Information, and choose BORROW. Then modify your dates.

Technical & Architectural Competitions: The competition will begin at 9:00 and will end at 1:00 pm. Once you have completed your competition, please leave all your work showing on the screen in the proper format (as outlined on the contest). Judges will be judging from the student's computer this year.

Animation Competition: This competition will last longer to allow the teams enough time to render, so please make special arrangements for travel to and from the GICC. The animation competition will begin at 9:00 and they should have the animation completed by 1:00 to allow enough time to render. The Animation will have to be rendered and at the judges desk by 3:00 pm. Remember you will need to have a 10 – 15 second frame animation, (2) 800 x 600 color stills and a color storyboard.
