

SkillsUSA Georgia Weekly Chapter Activities Week 2

Lesson Plan: Ice Breakers/Chapter Bonding

Objective: Through games allow student members to introduce themselves and form bonds.

Instructions:

- Sociometric Questions: This activity is simply a series of "sociometric" questions which require participants to arrange themselves in space in relation to other people according characteristics. Students will lineup left to right for the following statements (those students with the same answer should line up front to back):
 - 1. Alphabetically by first name
 - 2. Height
 - 3. Number of siblings
 - 4. Thumb size
 - 5. Number of soft drinks you drink per day
 - 6. Number of different states you have visited
 - 7. Amount of time you have been a SkillsUSA Member
- Human Bingo: Using the Bingo Card below, students go around the room looking for someone who fits the criteria of the individual squares. Once a person is found, the student asks them to sign the appropriate square and the student continues until they achieve BINGO (for longer player have the students fill all the squares). Feel free to alter the bingo spaces to fit your group.
