

SkillsUSA Georgia T-Shirt Design Contest Guidelines

Purpose:

To create a T-Shirt design that may be used as artwork for SkillsUSA Georgia t-shirts.

Eligibility:

Open to all active SkillsUSA members. Schools may enter more than one contestant. Contestants are eligible to enter additional contests. (Example: a Carpentry contestant may also enter the T-Shirt Design contest as well.)

Deadline:

All entries must register for this state only contest. Contest entries must be submitted at the designated time and place during the State Conference.

Awards:

Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place. The winner of this contest *does not* advance to the National SkillsUSA Leadership and Skills Conference.

Scope of the Contest:

1. The contestant will design a T-shirt that may be produced for use on SkillsUSA Georgia t-shirts.
2. Your design must be vector-based artwork saved as an Adobe Illustrator EPS file or as a PDF document. Art must be no bigger than 8 1/2 inches by 11 inches and contain no more than 4 PMS colors (this includes black). Art may not contain photographs, transparencies, gradients, or copyrighted material. All fonts should be outlined.
3. The t-shirt design should include one of the following:

SkillsUSA, SkillsUSA Georgia, or SkillsUSA Champions at Work logo.

Refer to the national website (www.skillsusa.org) for guidelines on properly using the SkillsUSA logo. The SkillsUSA emblem (or elements of) SHOULD NOT appear in the design. All copyright laws must be followed in the creation of the design.

3. At the appropriate time and place per the State Leadership and Skills Conference program, contestants will submit a printed copy of their t-shirt design and a CD containing an Adobe Illustrator EPS file or a PDF document.
4. All t-shirt designs become the property of SkillsUSA Georgia and may be used in reproduction and distribution.
